

<u>November - The month of the Holy Souls:</u> The envelopes are available now in the entrance hall. Please return them to the office, they will then be placed in the basket on the altar for the month of November.

<u>Baptism Course</u> – Any parent who is planning to have their child Baptised between the 9<sup>th</sup> December 2023 to the end of March 2024 should attend this course. The next course will take place in the Church on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> December 2023 11.00am-12.00 noon. Both parents should attend, one of whom must be a practicing Catholic.

<u>First Holy Communion 2024 –</u> First Holy Communion application forms for 2024 are now available in the Entrance Hall of the Church.

Children need to be in year 3 and above. Please complete and return the form to <u>the Parish Office</u> together with a <u>copy</u> of your child's <u>Baptismal Certificate</u> by <u>Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2023.</u> The programme will commence in the New Year.

<u>Confirmation 2024</u> – Applications for Confirmation in June 2024 are now closed for this year 2023-2024. Our young people for Confirmation this year have now commenced their journey, please keep them in your prayers.

<u>Bishops Visitation and Confirmation 2024</u> – Bishop Alan will be making his three yearly visit to the Parish on Sunday the 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2024. This is a pastoral Visit and very important for our Parish, he will also be administering the Holy Sacrament of Confirmation to 9 of our young people – a big day for them. so the Bishop will want to talk to parishioners, so please put it in your diary for 2024.

<u>Contactless Terminal for Offertory Collection</u> – Please do not forget we have a contactless terminal (near to the central doors into the church), or you can use the QR Codes – better still make a Standing Order using the details on this page.
